ROSE DISPLAY GUIDELINES

1. Place/Date: Hamilton County Fairgrounds, Noblesville, IN, Sat, June 10, 2017.
2. The rose display is open to anyone desiring to bring roses for public display.
3. The preparation area will open at 7:30 am EST Saturday, June 10, 2016.
4. Entries will be received from 7:30 am to 9 am
5. The show will be open to the public from 9:30 am - 1 pm
6. A limited number of vases will be available at the site and must be returned at the end of the event.
7. Aluminum foil, styrofoam or clear plastic wrap may be used as wedging material to position specimens in containers.
8. American Rose Society entry tags will be available at the event and used for placement of blooms. If known, the variety name should be entered on the tag or identified as "unknown".
Exhibitors name/address should be listed on each portion of the entry tag.
9. Display is not limited to a single entry of one variety. The exhibitor is encouraged to bring multiple blooms. All entries will be placed by the exhibitor.
10. Entries will not be judged, however, the public is encouraged to vote for their favorite entry for Hybrid Tea, Shrub, Fragrance, Photography and Arrangement. The public may also vote for their overall Best Entry of the Show. Winners will be recognized at the conclusion of the programs.

11. **SECTION A. - ROSE CLASSES**

Class 1	Hybrid Tea (one bloom) – <u>public vote</u>
Class 2	Hybrid Tea (open bloom)
Class 3	Floribundas (one bloom)
Class 4	Floribundas (spray)
Class 5	Shrubs – <u>public vote</u>
Class 6	Old Garden Roses
Class 7	Climbers
Class 8	Miniatures (one bloom)
Class 9	Miniatures (spray)
Class 10	Miniatures (open bloom)
Class 11	Miniflora (one bloom)
Class 12	Miniflora (spray)
Class 13	Miniflora (open bloom)
Class 14	Fragrance (any type) – <u>public vote</u>

12. **SECTION B - PHOTOGRAPHY CLASS** – **public vote**

1. Photograph must be 5 x 7 inches in size and be matted. A limited number of black mats will be provided and must be returned after the event.
2. Entries will be judged by the public.
3. Suggested entries are a rose specimen, rose garden or any activity involving the use of roses.

13. **SECTION C - ARRANGEMENT CLASS** – **public vote**

1. The exhibitor will provide their own container.
2. Arrangement should be any type that could be used in the home and may include any other type of plant materials or flower types.
3. Arrangement will be displayed on an open table without a backdrop.
